Job Description

St. Michael Academy, a Catholic Classical Academy in Petoskey, Michigan in the Little Traverse Bay region, is looking for a brilliant, energetic, and faith-filled educator to teach a wide variety of mathematics courses in our rigorous and inspiring high school curriculum. The bulk of the full-time teaching load for the position will span the fields of algebra and calculus, but an ability to teach Euclidian geometry would also be a plus. The position would commence August 15, 2021.

The St. Michael core curriculum is dedicated to propagating the harmony of faith and reason, and features an integrated and interdisciplinary approach to learning in general, including fields in the quadrivium. Mathematics is especially relevant when introducing students to matters of truth and falsehood, correctness and error, as well as rigorous logical reasoning. We are particularly interested in attracting candidates who can teach mathematics in a Socratic fashion that prioritizes the ability of students to demonstrate mathematical mastery in a live classroom setting.

The incumbent will also be asked to provide service to the entire high school, and perhaps teach other courses in our emerging junior high classical enrichment program.
